1. Meals

Meals will be provided as mentioned in the schedule above. We will provide meal coupons that can be used at the on-campus cafeteria and some restaurants.

Students have the option to purchase breakfast from the on-campus convenience store.

It is the student's responsibility to bring enough money to pay for the living expenses during free time: The price of one meal at the on-campus cafeteria is about 650 JPY, while at off-campus restaurants, it is around 900 JPY.

We also inform you that the restaurants and cafeterias on the campus will be closed on weekends but there are supermarkets and plenty of restaurants near the campus and dormitory. Students can use the shared kitchen in the dormitory, which has microwaves and refrigerators.
